- Develop and implement internal mechanisms for institutional learning, quality control, and programmatic integration, with guidance from the Team Lead (including tracking of key changes in the operating landscape and leveraging key opportunities to enhance organizational and programmatic growth).
- Provide leadership in identifying and testing key innovations which can enhance the effectiveness of existing programs, as well as designing/fundraising for new innovative programs aimed at strengthening STEM Education, civic engagement & Technology and Entrepreneurship.
- Ensure all programming adheres to Minimum Standards and aligns with internationally recognized best practices.
